### **YORK COUNTY CONSOLIDATED PLAN FISCAL YEARS 2010-2014**

#### **HOUSING COMPONENT OF THE YORK COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

York County is in the process of preparing a unified plan consisting of the 2010-2014 Consolidated Plan, which serves as the planning and application process for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development CDBG, HOME, and ESG Programs, and the Housing Component of the York County Comprehensive Plan. This joint Plan will provide a thorough examination of related plans and studies, particularly their priorities, goals and objectives, to distill down the key issues, countywide, and to formulate housing and community development strategies. The Plan will incorporate the requirements of both the PA Municipalities Planning Code and the US Department of Housing and Urban Development. As a result, the joint planning process will establish a shared, holistic vision of the state of housing and community development, and, in addition, develop principled and viable priorities to meet the housing and community development needs and goals of York County. When completed, the Unified Plan will guide the future housing and community development decisions of the County.
